- Adapt to the space usage and help to shape it



Educate Yourself

- Know about your spot and its usage
- Contact officials if you aim to conduct regular meetings



You have a right to public space

- Know your facts
- You are a respected member of the community



Establish Regularity

- Adapt your usage with the activities of others
- Always be there at similar times

Coordinate yourself with other groups

- Find experienced people
 - Define a spokesperson
 - Be nice and respectful
- Give valid reasons why you should be tolerated



Show Responsibility

- Leave your spot cleaner than you found it
 - Watch out for others
- Be proud of your image
 - Be safe



Be Approachable

- Have information material
 - Offer further information
- Actively communicate with all stakeholders
- Have information material and offer it



PRO TIPS

- TALKING TO OFFICIALS -

- BE NICE AND RESPECTFUL
- KEEP YOUR IMAGE AND COMPOSURE
- SHOW AND SHARE YOUR KNOWLEDGE
- TRY TO UNDERSTAND THE OFFICIAL'S POINT OF VIEW
- IMPROVE AND ENRICH YOUR PUBLIC SPACES
- TAKE PRIDE AND ENJOYMENT FOR YOUR SURROUNDINGS
- COMMUNICATE WITHIN THE GROUP
- DEFINE A PERSON TO TALK FOR THE GROUP
- KNOW OFFICIALS TO MENTION BY NAME AND NUMBER
- IF ASKED FOR PERMIT, ASK WHAT EXACTLY IT IS NEEDED FOR
- INFORM YOURSELVES BEFORE YOU ASK FOR A PERMIT
- GIVE THEM NO REASON TO SAY NO
- AND ABOVE ALL BE PERSISTANT!
